We made builder's helmets collage














We used the different tools and equipment that builders use to support our role-play; such as hammers and drills. We also had the opportunity to safely explore real tools as we helped to build a bookshelf.

Next Term Topics 。

We intended to cover the following topics in the summer term

Growth, Decay and Changes over Time-Through this topic we intend to develop an understanding of how the things in the natural world grow and decay over time.

Charity-Through this topic we intend to develop a sense of appreciation in our children for the many blessing that Allah has bestowed on us and create an awareness and empathy for the people less fortunate than us.

Animals and Mini-beast- We will also be exploring animals and other living creations of Allah, their nature and habitat. This will be followed with a visit to the **Willows Activity Farm** on 11th July Inshallah, provided our risk assessment identifies it is safe to do so. Letters will be sent closer to the time.

Seasons: Spring/Summer- the objective of this topic is to create awareness about the changes in the environment by exploring the colours and sounds associated with these seasons.
